- I. The Regulations are established in accordance with Article 26 of the University Act, Article 33 of Junior College Act, Article 43 of the Academic Policies of Wenzao Ursuline University of Languages and Article 11 of the Academic Policies of Junior College Division of the University.
- II. If, during the permitted period of study, the following criteria have been met, students from the four-year college program and the five-year junior college division may apply to graduate one semester or one academic year earlier; students from the two-year college program may apply to graduate one semester earlier. However, students who have transferred from other universities to study at the University cannot apply for early graduation.
 - (1) The student has completed all the courses and credits required for graduation and the average grade per semester is 80 or above.
 - (2) The student has passed the language proficiency test(s) and met relevant criteria set by his/her department(graduate Institute/degree Program).
 - (3) The student's grade of conduct performance is 80 or above for each semester.
 - (4) The student's grade average for compulsory physical education courses is 70 or above for each semester.
 - (5) The student has completed the required internship period, if applicable.
 - (6) At the time of application, the student's grade average over the years enables him/her to be ranked in the top 10% of his/her department(graduate Institute/degree Program) at the time of application.
- III. Applicants shall prepare the "Application for Early Graduation" within two weeks after the end of the add/drop period of the semester and submit the application with one copy of Chinese transcript of records and a course selection form for that semester to the Registration Section of the Academic Affairs Office (Academic Affairs Section of Continuing Education Division). The Registration Section of Academic Affairs Office (Academic Affairs Section of Continuing Education Division) will put together all the applications to be reviewed by various competent authorities and verify students' graduation qualifications. Once approved, the applications and list of graduating students for that semester will be ratified by the President. The student's transcript of records and the list of graduates will be marked with "early graduation".
- IV. Any matters not stipulated herein shall be conducted in accordance with Academic Policies of the University.
- V. The Guidelines become effective after approval by the Academic Affairs Committee and the

University Affairs Committee, ratification by the President, and submission to the Ministry of Education for future reference. Amendments must follow the same procedure.
